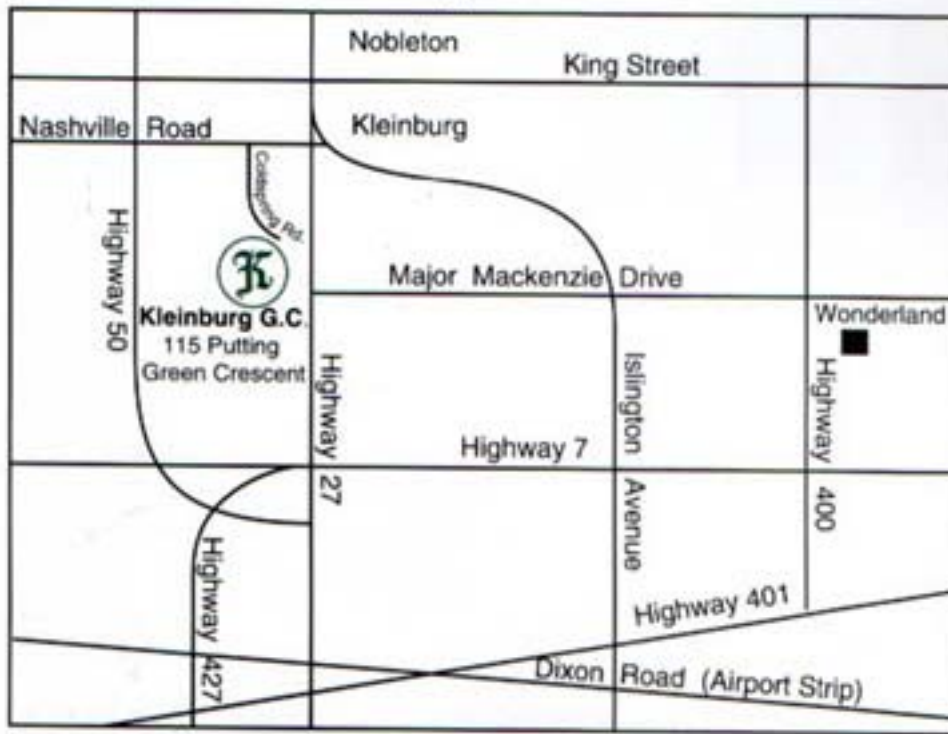

Kleinburg Golf Club
Alcohol Service Agreement

If a guest chooses to consume alcohol, Kleinburg Golf Club promotes responsible alcohol beverage service. While all the management and service staff of Kleinburg Golf Club have received training in the service of alcohol, the assistance of all guests to Kleinburg Golf Club staff is needed to ensure a positive and enjoyable experience.

Kleinburg Golf Club ("Kleinburg") and the Tournament/Event Convenor, on behalf of the tournament and its' participants, _____ agree to the following:

1. Kleinburg has the right to refuse alcohol service to a person who appears intoxicated.
2. If problems arise, Kleinburg has the right to close the bar and beverage service to all tournament/event participants.
3. Kleinburg encourages the tournament/event to provide alternate transportation to participants who choose to consume alcohol during the tournament and its following activities.
4. Tournament/Event participants are not allowed to bring their own alcohol onto Kleinburg property which includes the golf course, the parking lot and the clubhouse.
5. Kleinburg reserves the right to check a participant's golf bag if there is reasonable belief that the participant has brought his or her own alcohol onto Kleinburg property, in contravention of clause 4.
6. Kleinburg staff has the right to have golfers/guests removed from Kleinburg property in contravention of clause 4, if the participant is intoxicated or if the participant's conduct and behavior is deemed detrimental to the safety and enjoyment of other guests.
7. The Tournament/Event shall hold Kleinburg harmless for damages that may arise from a participant's intoxication, conduct and/or behavior.

House Policy of Kleinburg Golf Club

1. All persons who appear under the age of 25 will be asked for I.D.
2. No person under the age of 19 will be served alcohol.
3. No person who appears intoxicated will be served alcohol.
4. Kleinburg Golf Club reserves the right to cease service to anyone who appears to become intoxicated.
5. **Kleinburg Golf Club does not endorse drinking alcohol and driving.**
Any person who appears intoxicated will be asked how he or she intends to leave Kleinburg Golf Club. If the person is known or suspected to have driven a motor vehicle to the Club, he or she will be asked to give the keys of the vehicle to a staff member of the Club until such time as the person is sober. If the person refuses to give the keys of the motor vehicle and there is reasonable belief that the person will drive the motor vehicle while intoxicated, **the police will be called.**
6. Guests must be reminded that a golf cart is a motorized vehicle and that drinking and driving a golf cart is the same as drinking and driving a motor vehicle.
7. Arriving guests who appear intoxicated will not be allowed into areas of alcohol service.
8. Any person who is abusive or disruptive will be asked to leave the Kleinburg Golf Club property and if he or she refuses, the police will be called.
9. Guests cannot bring their own alcohol onto Kleinburg Golf Club property. If a guest is found with his or her own alcohol, the alcohol will be confiscated and he or she may be asked to leave the property.
